Student Snapshot: Miggy Matanguihan



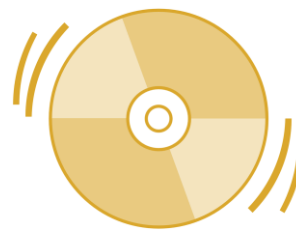
- **What year do you graduate?** “I’ll graduate 2023.”

There are occasions when the researcher wants words in close proximity to one another to increase relevance. EBSCO databases allow for proximity searching using the letter "N" and a numeral. For example, the search *tax N4 reform* will find *tax reform* and *reform of the United States tax code*.
