



In October 1977, Murray Library was dedicated after a year of construction and over \$3 million in fundraising. Today's Murray Library includes part of the original 1958 library, plus the 1977 addition, over 54,000 sq. ft! The building is named for architect William Lynch Murray and his wife Geraldine.



The Library uses the Library of Congress Classification (LOC) in the Main Stacks to categorize books. Books shelved near each other have similar topics.

Call numbers are on (or near) the spine of the book. The call number is made up of a combination of numbers and letters that are read left-to-right, top-to-bottom.


