# THE RESPONSIBILITY OF

I do'nt know of any man who fasts or who has fasted for forty days and forty nights. Instead of ever thinking of fasting, Church leaders like eating and others would even drink beer in addition normal meals which are also extravagant.

Christian leaders struggle by all means to be a better class? We have refused to serve but do all we can to be served. This is contrary to the teaching of Christ.

We have a duty to prove that the gospel is true and powerful. These days we must live and talk less. We are faced with a challenge to do what Jesus demands us to do. Our everyday life is the one that is responsible to the gospel. Those who know us, must see Christ in us.

Christians have been challenged by other religions. "Christians say this and then do its very opposite," one said. This is a painful thing to hear. But we are the ones who give this reputation by the way we live. Is it not true that while we do'nt drink beer or be involved in polygamy, we hate each other? Are we not guilty of witchcraft, pride and jealousy?

Some ministers of Christianity have defiled the gospel by their unquestionable quest for personal advancement. We should not delude ourselves by believing that we can appease God if we merely preach. We should bare fruits with acts of love.

A Christian organization employed a certain man notorious for his wicked heart. When the man got into the office, some people commented, "I cannot go there now, that man is very cruel. He hates people." This is an unfortunate situation for the gospel we preach. We should and do as the Bible says. That is our responsibility.

Jesus commissioned us to preach the gospel to the whole world. We must carry out this responsibility. Those who listen

to what we say must see us doing it. Let us not continue to defile the holy gospel of Jesus Christ. This gospel gives life everlasting to those who receive it. To be able to carry out our duty, Jesus Christ must be all to us. We mus discover his importance and value him more than everything. Then we won't be ashamed to be poor or rich for His Name's sake.

# A Debt To My Brethren

When I was baptized the Minister asked me some questions. "Are you willing to carry out your responsibilities to the church and to your fellow Brethren? If you will say yes." "Yes mfundisi I replied. Will you treat your Brethren according to Mt. 18?" And again I replied "I will Mfundisi."

Then just a few months after my Baptism one church member got pregnant. What did I do? "Rozi is pregnant. Did you know it?" I told Raphael. The next day I saw the Sunday School superintendent. "We hear that Rozi is pregnant. Have you heard it?" I asked her. In the afternoon, the same day I met Qinani who is not a Christian and I asked. "Qinani did you know that Rozi is pregnant? Yes she is. "But Rozi is a Christian, how come that she is pregnant?" Qinani inquired. And I replied, "This is a very bad thing. What Rozi has done is embarrassing."

The next day I met Rozi. "Hellow sister Rozi! How do you do? After a short conversation we parted. I never mentioned to her anything about pregnancy. On Sunday I whispered to somebody, "Look at her. They say she is pregnant." In less than a week the whole community is spreading a rumour about Rozi."

What have I done to help my beloved sister? Nothing. But I have added nail in crucifying her. She has a problem. That is true but why do I want everyone to know that she is a wicked person? Is it my duty to expose other members' sins without helping them? What is more helpful, to encourage her to return to the Lord, tell her that God forgives every sin confessed in true repentance, than to go about saying how evil she is?

A certain old church member heard that a youngman who once fell into sin had been elected to be a full time pastor by another church. The young man had repented, confessed his sin before the congregation and apologised. It was four or five years then. But this church elder

rushed to the minister in charge and said "So and so should not be be a full time pastor because he once did this and that. What a funny attitude! He had never talked to the youngman about it.

Who must help the weak? Are we not the ones? Can a man who is right with God, humble enough to see his own mistakes fail to talk to the Brethren but choose to spread bad rumours and lies? Honestly I discover how often I fail to identify my responsibility to my brethren to the Church and to God.

This common practice of spreading rumours, truths, half-truths and lies comes from loveless hearts. Hearts full of egoism, self-righteousness and Godlessne-"Who am I to judge another ss. Paul says, man's servant." James 4:12 Who am I to spread failures of fellow Christians? Jesus said, "Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye." If one ever fools himself, believing in his own righteousness, then that person is unfortunate. "...and all our righteousness our deeds of rightness and justice are as filthy rags or a polluted garment ----" Isa. 64:6. It makes no sense to go about talking about evils of other people while we are also exactly like them.

I have a responsibility to my neighbours and to Christian Brethren. If as Christians we get to an extent of spreading evils of our church members, we are surely destroying the body of Christ. But how many times have you wanted others to know the evils or sins of your fellow brethren? "A new commandment I give unto you; That ye love one another, as I have loved you -----. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples ...."John 13:34-35.

These years people wear outward uniforms, some preach openly, others publicly carry Bibles. Others are performing miracles. Many people therefore believe that these are signs to show that they are Jesus' disciples. That is far from this truth. Jesus said people will know that we are his disciples if we love one another. Whose disciples are we if we hate each other? The answer is very clear. We are the devil's disciples.

You and I are responsible to our brethren. We must pray for each other. We must correct, advise, warn, and encourage each other. We must come to the aid of our brethren who have been wounded by the devil. Condemning them or spreading rumours about them is being loyal to Satan and his angels already condemned to death for their disbodience to God.

# **Helps For The Personal**

# Worker

### • Handle With Care!

Personal work should be done with a delicate touch. This does not imply hesitation, but tactfulness, gentleness, and care.

### • The Natural Approach

Let the approach be as easy and natural as possible. Avoid the appearance of a studied artificiality on the one hand, and a blunt, hammer-andtongs abruptness on the other. Experience will enable the personal worker to know when, on occasion, a surprise attack is in order. See e.g. John 3:3; and compare with John 4:7 and Acts 8:30. As a rule, the approach that rises out of the circumstances naturally is the one to use.

### Keep It A Conversation — Don't Preach

Do not let the plea become a speech rather than a conversation. Cultivate the "conversational tone." Ask questions designed to "draw out" the prospect.

### e Try, Try Again

Rely more on persistence than on force. The continual dropping of the water will wear away the stone. More than a few have been won after many gentle but frequent nudges in God's direction.

### . No Pious Pose

Avoid the slightest suggestion of a holier-than-thou attitude, unless you want to arouse bristling resentment and stiffening resistance! And don't "talk down" to the prospect. As a matter of plain fact, many unconverted people are living quite decent and honorable lives outside the Church, and our efforts to evangelize them must be accompanied by humility.

### • Watch Your Step!

The personal worker must strive to live up to his Christian profession and ideals if he would be effective in his witness. Remember . . . "Let your light so shine before men . . ." (Matt. 5:16). The cannon must be heavier than its projectile. And the Christian must live a life consistent with the message he is delivering.

### e Keep The Door Open

Never press the prospect to the point where he can say no with such finality that the door is closed. If it becomes apparent that he is not ready or willing to make the right decision now, conclude the visit in such a way as to leave the way open for another time.

### Don't Fight!

Never argue with a prospect. Discuss, analyze, explain, persuade, to the best of your ability; but do not argue. Men are not usually convinced by argument — especially if it becomes heated! Keep your poise; hold your temper; be courteous always, even if you should be reviled (1 Pet. 2:20-23).

### e You Are God's Agent

Keep ever in mind the fact that you are engaged in God's work. Do it with dignity and sincerity, and in reliance on His interest and help. (What a powerful "secret weapon" we have in prayer!)

### You Are On Weighty Business

Remember that this work involves interests, values, and issues that are vast and eternal. We must not do it with flippancy or carelessness. If we do it with earnestness and care, then we may be sure that even our mistakes will be overruled by Divine providence and somehow made to further the Divine purpose. — Prepared by W. T. Strong.

The devil also uses fear to discourage the elect. Just ask yourself this question, "How many times have you heard an inner voice telling that if you obey God you may be in trouble?" The devil whispers cunningly, "Don't try to do it. fou are not capable. That is what people like Mr. Moyo do and not you." If you hear such a voice it is not from God. It is the devil's voice driving you away from God.

Doubt is another common weapon that Satan uses to attack faithful Christians. Some Christians hardly believe that God is hearing them when they pray. Some people repent but continue to doubt that they are saved. This is what the devil wants. The Book of Hebrews says, "Without faith it is impossible to please God." Hebrews 11:6.
